Choose some activities from each box for you and your child to enjoy doing together.  
Work on one activity a week and share your learning on your child's Portfolio.

### Literacy

- Choose your favourite story with fire in and bring the book in to share with the class. Can you explain what you like about it?
- Write a letter to a friend or family member, roll into a scroll and hand deliver to them.
- Create a postcard to someone about an imaginary adventure to a volcano.
- Keep a diary for the weekend and write about what you've been doing.
- Use bossy words to create a poster about how to stay safe around fire (e.g never, always).
- Research some poetry to share with the class!
- Create a family tree

### Maths

- Go to the shops to buy a snack, calculate what coins you will need and then how much change you will get.
- Practise and challenge your parents on their number pairs to 10 and 20 (e.g  $6+4=10$ ,  $7+3=10$ ,  $18+2=20$ ).
- Look at objects in your bedroom, what shapes can you find that are symmetrical?
- Create a tally chart of everyone's favourite after school snack. What's the most popular?
- Have a running race with someone in your family. Who came first? How long did they take?
- Make a table to show your family's eye/hair colours

### Topic

- Make a junk model of a volcano. Record a list of the materials you used.
- Research some of the most important historical fires. Bring it in to share with the class.
- Draw, paint or collage a picture of something burning.
- With an adult, plan, prepare and cook a meal over fire for your family to enjoy.
- Listen to some traditional bonfire songs. Compare the instruments or lyrics used to modern songs.
- With your family, go for a walk up Rivey Hill. Why might fire spread so quickly in times of drought?
- Can you think of any stories from the bible which mention fire?
