<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Write a book review for your favourite bed-time story.</li><li>• Write a letter to a friend or member of your family to thank them for a Christmas gift.</li><li>• Instead of a chocolate machine like in <i>Charlie and the Chocolate Factory</i>, write a story with your own invention.</li><li>• Write 4 sentences about your favourite film using an apostrophe for contraction in each.</li><li>• Write a free verse poem about an imaginary invention.</li><li>• Write about or take a picture of something special you do as a family for your learning log.</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Share out movie night treats out equally between your family and write it down as a number sentence.</li><li>• Practise and challenge your parents on their 2, 3, 5 and 10 times table.</li><li>• Write a timetable of your dream day as a famous singer with at least 10 activities and the time you would do them.</li><li>• Measure one or more of the bridges in Linton and compare their lengths.</li><li>• Estimate how many litres you think it will take to fill a bath and then find out.</li><li>• Design your own invention using only 2d shapes. Have your family ask questions about the shape properties to try and copy it themselves without looking.</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Explore materials to create your own bridge and find out how much weight it can hold.</li><li>• Invent your own Minecraft world and take a screenshot to show us.</li><li>• Invent your own musical instrument perhaps using a cardboard box and elastic bands – can you create a repeating pattern pulse?</li><li>• Build a theatre set for each UK capital city from recycling. Can you show these on a map?</li><li>• Help your parents make a meal from a different continent.</li><li>• Create a poster to teach your family how to be safe online.</li></ul>
